The Spring 2024 semester of Driver Education will begin the week of March 4th. The fee is \$525, which must be submitted any day starting Tuesday, February 20th, and ending on Wednesday, February 28th, in the form of a money order payable to St. Joseph by-the-Sea High School. Payment should be submitted to Mr. Gilsenan in the Student Services Office across from the library or directly to Mr. Manisero no later than Wednesday, February 28th. Once again, submission dates run from Tuesday, February 20th through Wednesday, February 28th.

Students must be 16 years of age by March 4th in order to register.

- 1. All tuition and fees must be current with the school's bursar in order to register.
- 2. The cost for the Spring 2024 semester is \$525.
- 3. Payment must be made by money order. Personal checks will not be accepted.
- 4. Students must be 16 years of age by March 4th in order to participate.

Phases of the Program

Part 1–Behind the Wheel

-Hands-on experience with a licensed driver education teacher

Part 2–Learning the Laws

-Lecture class-rules of the road, DWI, laws and consequences, and insurance information

Fall Program Dates

- 1. The course runs from March 4th through the end of June.
- 2. Driving will take place over the Easter break only if students and instructors are available.
- 3. Any days missed because of a holiday or teacher cancellation will be made up at a different time.

Rules for Students

- 1. Proper classroom behavior is required. All interactions with teachers and other students are subject to the same expectations as a regular school day.
- 2. Excessive absences would lead to removal from the program, and the fee would not be refunded.
- 3. Students are not permitted use of cell phones or any other electronic devices during lessons.

New York Laws

- 1. Parents are not permitted to practice with students in New York City.
- 2. The law states that you must have a dual brake and a driver education/driving school license to practice with an unlicensed/permit driver anywhere in the five boroughs.
- 3. A New York permit is not necessarily recognized in other states.
- 4. If you are 16 or 17 years of age, the following rules apply:

a. Possess a permit for a minimum of six months from the issue date in order to take the road test.

b. Possess the MV262 form with parent signature, which will be given to the student at the end of the semester, in order to take the road test.

c. Possess the MV285 certificate which will be given to the student at the end of the semester upon the successful completion of the course in order to take the road test.

***Please remember that driving is a privilege, not a right. Students must understand the significance of this responsibility and must demonstrate a mature attitude towards this undertaking. Parental Consent Form for Registration Spring 2024
