Dear Parents:

The month of October is traditionally dedicated to the Most Holy Rosary, because the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary is on October 7. Friday, October 3 is the First Friday of the month and we will gather in the Gym for First Friday Mass. Prior to mass, the students will have an opportunity to go to Confession. Chris Bell from Good Counsel Homes will be addressing the students after communion at Mass.

All too often, we take it for granted that a Catholic school will provide a traditional Catholic education and help parents instill our values and beliefs in the next generation. Meanwhile, we can sometimes fail to appreciate the tremendous influence that our modern culture has on our young people and that the values absorbed are sometimes not the ones we are trying to instill. Here at Sea we are doing our very best to pass the faith along to the children you have entrusted to our care, but I do not believe for one minute that we could do it without God's help and the only way to get that help is through prayer. So during the month of October, students will have the opportunity to join in the recitation of the Rosary every Thursday at 2:45 PM in the courtyard (or in the Chapel if it rains).

The month of October brings our Open House for eighth graders. Open House is scheduled for Sunday October 19 (Girls) and Sunday October 26 (Boys) and is by appointment only. While this arrangement was launched during the pandemic, we found that it worked so well (people do not need to wait around, etc.) that we will use it this year as well. 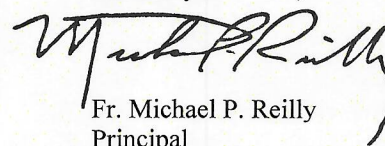
The new parking lot in front of the school has added ninety parking spots to our campus. It is critical that everyone observes parking regulations:

1. Park only within lined spots.
2. Do not park in any place designated as *no parking*, particularly the fire lanes at the entrance to the school and along the fence in the back parking lot.
3. Do not obstruct the gate near the Concession Stand in the back as we need it to get an ambulance on to the field when (God forbid) it is necessary.

Finally, the month of October is dedicated to respect for human life in all its stages from conception to natural death. As you may have heard, our students have dedicated the month of October to raising money for Good Counsel Home (<https://www.goodcounselhomes.org/>). Good Counsel is a nationally recognized nonprofit leader and innovator in creating supportive residential care and community-based services for homeless, expectant, and new mothers and their children in the context of the Catholic social tradition. Chris Bell, the Founder and Director of Good Counsel Home, will address our student body after communion at our Mass on October 3. The students will be organizing some small fundraisers (dress down, spirit day, bake sale, etc.) for that purpose throughout this month and the proceeds will be donated to Good Counsel Home.
